Modern Slavery Policy

Oxford Professional Education Group is a private training provider supporting employers and learners by developing and delivering knowledge, skills and behaviour training.

We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern-day slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business.

Our supply chains include publishing and printing services, I.T services, training venue suppliers, training providers, consultants, and marketing services. Before entering into formal contracts with these suppliers we have reviewed the risks that these supply chains can present.


We expect our suppliers and contractors not to tolerate exploitation in any way. We would not knowingly contract or deal with any business involved in slavery, human trafficking, or exploitation.

As part of our due diligence procurement process, we will only engage with suppliers and contractors who confirm their compliance with the Modern Slavery Act.

We will keep our staff informed and aware of how to recognise and respond to signs of human rights abuse.

We will adapt and promote our existing company policies to incorporate modern slavery and human trafficking issues, including our whistleblowing policy which allows employees to report any concerns confidentially.
